What day does camp start?

The first day of camp is Monday, August 21, 2023 (Week 1) or Monday, August 28, 2023 (Week 2).

Where do I drop off and pick up my child?

The location for drop off and pick up is 58-20 Little Neck Parkway at the Sam Field Center Front Door. Parents and caregivers are welcome on Monday morning to meet the staff and receive a tour of the gymnasium.

****Parents and caregivers are asked to be timely for drop off and pick up.**

Can I drop my child off early and pick them up late?

Extended care is available from 8-9am for \$30 a week and 4-6pm for \$60 a week

Is there bus transportation to/from camp from my neighborhood?

There is no bus transportation to or from our mini-camp in Little Neck.

What are your COVID19 policies?

Covid-19 Policies and Procedures:

- Our priority is the health and safety of our community. Commonpoint Queens follows the guidance provided by the New York State Department of Health, New York City Department of Health, CDC, and the New York City Department of Education.
- As Governor Kathy Hochul has lifted the statewide mask mandate, we would like to make you aware that mask wearing will now be optional for campers and staff.
- All camp staff are fully vaccinated.

Do you provide lunch and/or snacks?

Lunch and snacks are not provided. Campers should bring their own Kosher, nut-free lunch, snacks and water bottle every day.

What should my child pack for camp?

- A nut-free kosher lunch, water bottle and snacks every day.
- A back-up change of clothes including t-shirt, shorts, socks and underwear.
- Sun protection (hat, sunscreen). *It is a good idea to apply sunscreen to your child before camp.
- A swimsuit, goggles, towel and flip flops.
- Please label everything with your child's name so if it is misplaced, it can be easily identified and returned.
- **Campers are NOT required to bring their own sports equipment.

Will my child swim every day? Will he/she be given swim lessons? Do you provide towels?

Swimming is included for campers every day. Swim time is recreational (no lessons provided) and supervised by lifeguards, aquatics staff and counselors. Campers should bring a bathing suit, towel bathing cap, swim goggles and waterproof shoes to wear on the pool deck (flip flops or crocs).

What is the daily schedule?

All campers will get dropped off at 9:00 a.m.

In the morning, campers will board the bus for their field trip. Campers will return to the Sam Field Center for lunch followed by sports play. Following sports play, there will be a 30 minute swim period at the outdoor Tanenbaum Family Pool. The campers will change back into dry clothes and play games and other activities until pick-up at 4:00 p.m.

How many campers are in a group? What is the ratio of counselors to campers?

There may be up to 25 campers in a group. The ratio of campers to staff can vary from 5-to-1 to 8-to-1 depending on the age of the campers and activity.

Is there a nurse or medical care available on site?

Select camp staff are trained in emergency medical care and CPR. In the event of an emergency, agency protocols will be strictly followed.

May I sign up for mini-camp by the day?

Mini-camp registration is weekly, not daily. Credit or refunds will not be issued for missed days.

What is the refund policy?

Our refund policy is as follows:

BEFORE August 1: 100% refund minus \$20 administrative fee.

BEFORE August 15: 90% refund minus \$20 administrative fee.

AFTER August 15: 50% refund minus \$20 administrative fee.

Once Mini-Camp begins, no refunds or credits will be issued. No refunds or credits will be issued for missed days.
